Pine Hill Ski Club (PHSC) is a not-for-profit, cross-country ski area open to all lovers of Nordic skiing located throughout New London, Sutton and Wilmot. The land is owned by 12 generous landowners including the Town of New London and the New London Conservation Commission.

All fees are used for the upkeep of 20 kilometers of trails, signage, insurance, grooming machines, loaner ski equipment and services. PHSC is managed by a volunteer board of directors and members who love cross-country skiing.
